We ask that you read this cookie policy carefully as it contains important information on and our use of cookies on our websites.

What are cookies? Archiving

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by online service providers to help build a profile of users. They are also used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies and the websites below explain how to remove cookies from your browser. However, some of our websites features may not function as a result.

Types of cookies

The cookies we place on your device fall into the following categories:

- **Session cookies**—these allow our websites to link your actions during a particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser and do not remain on your device afterwards
- Persistent cookies—these are stored on your device in between browser sessions. These
 allow your preferences or actions across our websites to be remembered. These will
 remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them from your cache
- **Strictly necessary cookies**—these cookies are essential for you to be able to navigate our website and use its features. Without these cookies, the services you have asked for could not be provided
- **Performance cookies**—these cookies collect information about how you use our websites, e.g. which pages you go to most often. These cookies do not collect personally identifiable information about you. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous, and is only used to improve how our websites works
- Functionality cookies—these cookies allow our websites to remember the choices you make (such as your user name, language, last action and search preferences) and provide enhanced, more personal features. The information collected by these cookies is anonymous and cannot track your browsing activity on other websites

The cookies we use

Just Giving	Marketing	 Collects data on the visitor's use of the comment system on the website, and what blogs/articles the visitor has read. This can be

		used for marketing purposes.
You Tube	Necessary and Marketing	 To estimate the user's bandwidth on pages with integrated YouTube videos. To register a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen. Storing the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video. Used to detect if the visitor has accepted the marketing category in the cookie banner.
Google Analytics	Statistics	 Logs details about the visitor's browser and computer. Number of times a user has visited the website as well as dates for the first and most recent visit. Exact time when the user accessed the website, leaves the website and duration of the visit. To review visitor behaviour to target larger groups. To throttle speed of requests to server. To detail where the user came from, what search engine was used, what link was clicked and what search term was used. Generate statistical data on how they use the website and number of times visited the website.

How we use your cookies

Remarkable Autism Ltd may request cookies to be set on your computer or device. Cookies are used to let us know when you visit our websites, how you interact with us and to make your experience using the websites better for you. The cookies we collect will differ depending on what you are looking at on our websites. You are able to adapt your cookie preferences, but

by blocking certain types of cookie it may mean that your experience on the website is impacted.

Consent to use cookies

We will ask for your permission (consent) to place cookies or other similar technologies on your device, except where these are essential for us to provide you with a service that you have requested (eg to enable you to put items in your shopping basket and use our check-out process).

There is a notice on our home page which describes how we use cookies and requests your consent to place cookies on your device.

How to turn off cookies

If you do not want to accept cookies, you can change your browser settings so that cookies are not accepted. If you do this, please be aware that you may lose some of the functionality of this website.
